

EXPO 2023 Pet Access Policy

At **EXPO2023**, we welcome both our visitors and their four-legged companions, striving to create a comfortable and safe environment for all attendees. Given the range of activities and high footfall, we have established the following guidelines for animals on the premises:

- 1. Domestic Animal Access: Only domestic animals are permitted within the EXPO2023 grounds. Wild, exotic, or potentially dangerous animals are strictly prohibited.
- 2. Safety and Behavior: Animals should not display aggressive tendencies or pose any threat to others. Special attention should be given to an animal's behavior in crowded settings, amidst loud music, or other potential stressors.
- **3. Size and Inspection**: The animal's size must conform to set limits to ensure a safe check at security checkpoints (PSA).
- 4. Guidelines for Dogs: All dogs must be always on a short leash. Dogs that are over 50 cm at the withers are required to wear a muzzle. Fighting dog breeds and other potentially hazardous breeds are not allowed on the EXPO2023 premises.
- **5. Dog owner is responsible to collect and dispose dog waste.** It must be picked up, bagged and disposed of in the litter bin.
